


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Central Moravia region is characterized by its rich history and a range of significant historical sights. Historic town centres attract visitors by their unique atmospheres and show their most valuable treasures. You can take a look inside dark as well as romantic castles and chateaus, learn more about our history thanks to many museums, and you can taste our traditional food specialities.

The Central Moravia landscape is very exciting not only for nature lovers but also for all people loving active holidays. You can – in accordance to your physical condition – choose among many activities: hiking, cycling or horseriding in the charming countryside, going down Morava river or doing other sport activities in many sport parks and resorts.

Adventures in Central Moravia

Bobsleigh tracks



Do you like the feeling of wind howling around you? Try some of the bobsleigh tracks - safe adrenalin inducing entertainment- in Central Moravia. For example the bobsleigh track in Hlubočky, open all year long, leads through a special ditch. It offers a 1540 m long ride, 1030 m downhill. What is more, there are many twists, a tunnel and a bridge construction. Currently it is the longest track in Moravia. Rail bobsleigh track in Sport park Hrubá Voda is one of the most modern tracks. Hilly, attractive, fast and maximally safe. It is open all year and is suitable for all age brackets.

Canoeing and rafting on the Morava river



Welcome on the beautiful Morava river. You can go canoeing or rafting with the help of an experienced instructor through a natural protected area. The river flows through a charming landscape and unique woodland meadows, where besides rare fauna and flora you can also spot a beaver. The most frequent part of Morava river leads from Hanušovice to Olomouc. It is about 100 km long. You can meet meanders blocked with alluvium, passable as well as impassable weirs, however, do not let it discourage you. Starting in Postřelmov the way is suitable also for beginners.

Javoříčko caves



An underground system of Javoříčko caves forms a complicated complex of tunnels, cave chambers and chasms created inside an island of Devon calcites by the Špraněk stream. Today visitors enter the caves by a man-made entrance right into a 'Detritus Cave'. This cave is beautifully decorated with stalactites and stalagmites. On the ceiling you can see thousands of stalactites and curtains of many forms and sizes. The next part of the cave is called 'Lion hollow', which is 60 m deep and is connected with a system of corridors and chasms on the middle and lower floor. Then the visitors go along a beautifully decorated high corridor into the magnificent 'Cave of Giants'. This part was discovered as early as in 1938 during a several-

hour difficult pass through the lower floor. 4 m high stalagmites dominate this huge space, on the walls you can see the so called 'Niagara falls'. A staircase leading to 'Fairytale caves' offer the best view over this part. Javoříčko Caves offer much more and are said to be the most beautiful caves in the Czech Republic.

Sluňákov and The house of nature



A unique outdoor exposition about the nature of Litovelské Pomoraví. This open-air gallery connects the countryside to pieces of work by famous Czech artists – František Skála, Miloš Šejna, Miloslav Fekar and Marcel Hubáček. On the large land you can find picturesque corners, untraditional objects and a nice place where you can sit-down and relax. This forms a unique open-air gallery – e.g. 'Paradise garden', 'Forest temple', 'Sunny mountain of dreams' and others. This area is a place where you can absorb nature with all senses. The entry is free, and suitable for families with baby carriages, cyclists and disabled people.

Hranice abyss



Hranice abbys in Přerov region is, with its depth of 404 m under water level, the deepest flooded cave in the world. Above the water level there is also a dry part, so called 'Dry rotunda', 69,5 m high. This abyss is located on the right bank of Bečva river in Hranice karst not far from Zbrašov aragonite caves. Neither a measuring probe nor a mini submarine has reached the bottom so far. Hranice karst is a unique area. It was not formed by corrosions of water leaking from the surface but by strong thermal springs coming from the depths.

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MORAVA CAMP ****



Recreational area Morava Camp is situated in a beautiful forest park on the periphery of the town Mohelnice. It lies in a very attractive area for tourists, Litovelké Pomoraví, near Bouzov castle, Jeseníky mountain range, Velké Losiny thermal spa, Mladeč and Javoříčko caves and many cycling ways.

Accommodation is possible in a newly reconstructed motel, caravans or tents. All rooms and cabins are strictly non-smoking. Each room in the motel has its own bathroom with a toilet, towels as well as bedding are provided. Cabins provide bedding, power outlets and a table. In kitchens there are basic electrical appliances running on coins (cooker, washing machine) and a fridge.

During summer season we prepare animation entertainment programmes and regularly we organise sausage roasting above the fire in the big fireplace.

TRAVEL TIP Bouzov castle

Bouzov castle is a favourite place of many tourists. It offers classic guided tours as well as evening tours and tours in costumes. The castle is fully furnished and equipped. All pieces of furniture and other valuable items come mostly from private collections of archduke Evžen Habsburský and partly from collections of the German order. New equipment was produced specially for this building. The most valuable part of the castle is a neogothic chapel with its gothic altar. The chapel is decorated with gravestones of masters of the religious order. A castle armoury, which is a former gothic hall of the old castle, is equipped by various weapons.





A restaurant is a part of the area and is focused on Czech cuisine. It offers many kinds of meals daily. It is possible to reserve breakfast, half board, full board or just come and have lunch or dinner. The restaurant offers a wide choice of alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks, draught beer Holba and Šerák, coffee of high quality and for children Opočno ice cream.

The restaurant is wheelchair accessible, there is, of course, wifi and a small children's play area. Credit cards are accepted. Outside you can play tennis, beach volleyball or minigolf. In summer you can enjoy a reconstructed swimming pool with a paddling pool, snack bar and a playground. Children will like the children's room, playground or training field. Sport equipment and bicycles both for children and adults are rentable here.



Museum of Olomouc smelly cheese Loštice

It has been opened on a place of a former cheese manufacture since 1994. In the basement, where the exhibition begins, you can see how the cottage cheese was milled and pressed, on other floors the manufacturing itself as well as the producers and their life stories are documented. Many of the documents and records are original and unique. During the tour you can watch a film 'A story of an unusual aroma from uncle Křópal's storytelling' – a free film version of the history of smelly cheese production.



CAMPING BALDOVEC s.r.o. ***



OPEN: YEAR ROUND GPS: 49°24'46.9"N 16°48'31.2"E



Recreational resort Baldovec is situated in Moravian karst, only a couple of kilometres from Macocha abyss.

It lies in a charming valley Bílá Voda and is surrounded by deep woods and pure nature. This resort is unique mainly for it's wide range of free-time activities. It offers accommodation in many cathegories: from basic cabins to luxurious ones and apartments. For those who prefer sleeping outside, the camp provides 40 000 m2 for visitors ´ with their own tents or caravans. Power outlets are available here for hire.

For relaxation Baldovec offers a water world with a whirlpool, two saunas, heated deckchairs and other subsequent services.

For the visitors there is also a restaurant with a terrace, wellness centre with a salt cave, massages, adrenalin centre with rope activities and a climbing tower, paintball, archery, tennis courts, beach volleyball courts or a football pitch.

TRAVEL TIP

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Aquapark Koupelky Prostějov

In this precinct you can enjoy three swimming pools with many attractions. Two helter-skelters, a water slide, kamikaze, artificial waves, stream channel, bubbles and others. For children there is a playground with a climbing wall and a children 's pool. Besides water sports you can play volleyball, basketball and tennis here. If you like pétanque, there are two fields for this game.





Great meals and perfect accommodation is provided all year long. Parking is possible in the area near the cabins.

As already mentioned, Baldovec is located in Moravian karst, only a couple of kilometres from Macocha abyss, therefore it is an ideal place for nature lovers. there are Interesting trips around and an active way of spending free time, these are the main advantages of staying here. Baldovec is a complex centre in the middle of the countryside. It can form a basis for a perfect holiday or a company event.



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Plumlov dam


Plumlov dam was built on Hloučela river in order to protect the land from floods. It is one of the oldest dams in the Czech Republic. The construction started as early as in October 1912. In 1933 it was finished and the dam was filled up with water. Plumlov dam offers many activities and ways to spend free time. For instance an open-air cinema or minigolf, which is situated right under the embankment. For hikers there are many marked paths around the dam, in the woods or for example to the nearby Plumlov castle.



CAMP ŠTERNBERK **

The camp serves as a point of departure for hikers and cyclists as well as for car trips around Šternberk. There are many sights, castles, chateaus, caves, mineral springs and a ZOO. The location of the campsite enables walks to the countryside to all directions. Following touristic signs, you can walk on marked paths around all day long.





In the castle you can see a unique collection of Italian and Nordic early renaissance paintings as well as some pieces of Dutch and Flemish baroque painting. The next interesting part are noblemen 's interiors from last centuries or a valuable collection of gothic and renaissance wooden sculptures. For instance a relief 'St.Kunhuta's suffering' is one of the oldest renaissance well-preserved woodcuts in Moravia. This castle shows also the life of modern aristocrats from the beginning of 20th century - hot-air heating, bathrooms and a lift for meals 10 are presented here. In the settlement around the castle there is a unique museum of clocks.





Similarly, cyclists can enjoy marked cycling ways. For car lovers there is an exhibition showing a history of a car race Ecce Homo www.eccehomopark.cz

Visitors coming by car have the possibility to visit many places in the whole Olomouc region and in the central Haná area. During late summer and the beginning of autumn you can pick mushrooms in the forests around. A place for swimming is situated cca 1 km up the stream of river Sitka, in a large natural swimming area, or in a town swimming pool with a helter-skelter 3 km away. If you take the back gate from the camp there is an old concrete swimming pool with a children 's playground and a snack bar about 200 m far away. For swimming you can also use sand pits nearby. It is also possible to spend time actively directly in the resort. You can rent sport equipment and play for example badminton, football, table tennis or board games.

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Time exposition Šternberk

Time exposition is a project, in which the town of Šternberk follows its own tradition, as Šternberk is known as 'a town of clocks'. Time in all possible contexts is shown here. The exposition tells an attractive story recording 14 million years from the Big Bang to an atom clock. More than 20 Czech museums as well as other museums from all over the world have contributed with unique objects and interactive programmes to this project. Come to entertain and learn! You will see that time is flying faster here. All age groups, children as well as their parents, will definitely enjoy this exposition.



RESORT KRÁSNÁ MORAVA



Resort Krásná Morava is a beautiful natural area not far from the centre of Olomouc.

This area on the banks of a creek Mlýnský potok offers accommodation in tents and caravans. Thanks to its location it is suitable for canoeists or tourists interested in Olomouc and its history. You can walk or ride on rented scooters directly to the center. Cyclists can go on a trip to the charming scenery of Litovelské Pomoraví. As far as meals are concerned, the camp provides a garden grill to rent or you can eat in a snack bar.


Krásná Morava resort organises summer cultural events. More information about these programmes are to be found on websites in advance.

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TRAVEL TIP ZOO Svatý Kopeček

In this ZOO there lives more than 1700 animals of more than 300 kinds. In five pavilions and many outside areas and expositions you can also see some rare species. Children will love a small train going through the ZOO or the 32 m high lookout, which you cannot see anywhere else. This ZOO specializes in giraffes, African hoofed animals, nordic fauna and sea aquariums. A giant shark aquarium is a rarity, it is the biggest aquarium of its kind in the Czech Republic. Besides this one, there are many beautiful sea aquariums with coral reefs. A big experience is the pavilion of bats flying 12 above your heads. What is more, in the middle of this ZOO, there is a big rope centre for children.





AMK Camp Hranice is located right next to a national nature reserve Hurka in Moravskoslezské Beskydy valley. It offers a quiet holiday mainly for families with children and hikers. Accommodation is possible in tents, caravans and cabins,

In the resort you can find a playground, table tennis and a place for playing so called 'Russian skittles'. Nearby there is a swimming pool Hranice, a golf court and a tennis court. If you prefer to watch the countryside around from horseback, you can go to a riding school, located 5 km far from the campsite. The camp restaurant offers meals daily.



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TRAVEL TIP Zbrašov aragonite caves

Zbrašov aragonite caves lie in a charming valley of a river in Teplice nad Bečvou spa resort. They were discovered in 1912 and in 1926 they were opened to the public. They form a unique cave system in Europe. These caves were formed by an interaction of atmospheric water and warm mineral water coming from the depths. A mineral aragonite makes a unique decoration inside, next you can see so called raft stalagmites.



CAMPING ŽRALOK PLUMLOV









Camping Žralok Plumlov is situated on the bank of a peaceful pond Podhradský rybník at the foothills of Drahanská vrchovina. It lies outside the village Plumlov near the forests. Right from the campsite there is a breathtaking view of the castle Plumlov.

Accommodation is possible in your own tents, caravans or cabins.


In the resort there is a snack bar, a playground, a day room with a terrace, a volleyball court and a fireplace.

During the summer season many interesting sports as well as cultural events are organised here. Swimming is possible in Podhradský pond.

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TRAVEL TIP Castle Plumlov

Castle Plumlov above the pond Podhradský rybník is located in the village of Plumlov. It was bulit by Jan Adam from Lichtenstein during 1680-1688. The building was supposed to have three wings with a rich decorated facade. Unfortunately just a torso has remained and the building has never been occupied. Inside you can see three castle expositions: a castle history with a pottery, weapons and furniture collection. The second guided tour includes 'Fairytale basements' with a storytelling about Plumlov and its surroundings. The third one is very special and includes a little bit adrenalin. It shows rooms on











Camp Přehrada Mostkovice lies above Plumlov dam, a popular place with tourists. From this place you also have a nice view of Prostějov.

The dam is a favourite place for swimming in summer. There are plenty of places around which are worth visiting - both on foot or on a bike. Nearby there is for example Plumlov Castle or the historic centre of the town Prostějov.

In the resort you can rent sports equipment such as balls, tennis rackets or petangue and use them on the multipurpose playing field inside the campsite. Under the dam you can play minigolf, beach volleyball and on the beach you can rent a boat or a paddle boat. Around you can ride a horse as well.

The visitors of this camp can cook in separate kitchens, eat in the snack bar or go to the nearby restaurant. In the campsite there are common sanitary facilities.

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TRAVEL TIP Čechy pod Kosířem chateau

It is a classicistic chateau surrounded by a beautiful park that belongs to the most valuable areas with historic green vegetation in all of Moravia This park is connected to an aristocratic dynasty Silva-Tarouca. Josef Mánes, a famous Czech painter, was a close friend of this family. He regularly visited Čechy pod Kosířem and made his pieces of work here in 1849 - 1871. Inside the chateau you can admire a reconstructed greenhouse and beautiful interiors. The greenhouse serves as a café nowadays. In autumn 2016 a minizoo was created here.

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TRAVEL TIP Tovačov Chateau

Tovačov Chateau is a very valuable sight. It used to be a castle built on a swampy terrain on the east periphery of the town. During the period of late Cimburk the castle was rebuilt into a renaissance chateau. Inside, besides many thematic exhibitions, you can see a renaissance portal of a castle tower, a castle chapel with a neobaroque plastering, the left wing of the castle with a staircase in the Vienna style and a ceremony room of the town. Since 2012 it is possible to visit 'Knights' hall' and 'Salmovsky hall' again. In the vestibule there is a new exposition of a 'snooker room', also called 'men's room'. Reaching the top of 16 the castle tower and looking around is an unforgettable experience.



IN LIFE CAMP LITOVEL



The camp is situated on Morava river and a cycling way in Litovel. It is intended not only for canoeists and cyclists but is suitable for all families. Directly in the camp you can rent a canoe, raft, kayak and all water and sports equipment. Parents as well as children will definitely enjoy the activity centre IN LIFE or water attractions - aquazorbing, children's paddle boats, bumper ball and other.

If you need to prepare your own meals, you can use metal portable fireplaces. In the outside bar or in a nice restaurant nearby you can try great local Litovel beer. Trips around are best on rented scooters, for example to the natural swimming pool 100 m away.

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CANOEING CAMPING AREA HYNKOV

This favourite camping area for canoeists Hynkov is situated on the right bank of Morava river and serves as an ideal stop on the way from Litovel to Olomouc.

It lies in the middle of this way near a local pub, so it is a great place to stop and refresh yourself during hot summer days. Canoeists who also like other sports can use a small football pitch or a tennis court.

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TRAVEL TIP Náměšť na Hané chateau

A town Náměšť na Hané lies on the east part of Drahanská vrchovina, only about 15 km west from Olomouc. In this town you can visit a late baroque chateau surrounded by a French park. About 20 rooms, fully furnished in different historic styles, are open to the public. The collections of Czech, Vienna and Chinese porcelain are very interesting, the most valuable is a collection of Dresden china. An original library with almost three thousand books is very unique and is worth seeing. A part of chateau expositions forms also a modern art gallery.



STODOLA NOVÉ MLÝNY



OPEN: YEAR ROUND GPS: 49°43'56"N, 16°59'46"E



This barn ("stodola") is located in a small settlement Nové Mlýny between towns Mohelnice and Litovel. Its name refers to its former use, when this building belonged to a millhouse situated on the opposite bank of Morava river. Forty years ago this barn burned down. Nowadays it is newly reconstructed in its original rustic style. If you need a quiet place for an overnight stay, this is the right place for you.



The camping area on a meadow around the barn provides the possibility to sleep in a tent and a large space for sport. You can rent a canoe and some sports equipment here.

This area is located in the beautiful and clean surroundings of a protected landscape area Litovelské Pomoraví. The place is a favourite mostly for its beautiful scenery. What is more. Morava river flows right next to this camp, so this place is very popular with canoeists.

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TRAVEL TIP Bílá Lhota Arboretum

Not far from Litovel, in a chateau park in Bílá Lhota, an arboretum with 400 kinds of rare woods is situated. These leafy, coniferous and all year long green trees and bushes come from north America, Japan, China and many other countries. This park was probably created around the year 1700 during chateau renovations but at that time it was planted with common trees and bushes. In 1926 Quido Riedl, a famous dendrologist, came to Bílá Lhota and transformed the park according to his conception. On the place of 3 hectares he planted about 500 kinds





Vila Háj guest house is located in the Háj settlement on Morava river, in the beautiful surroundings of Litovelské Pomoraví. Visitors have the possibility to stay in a guest house directly in the first-republic villa or camp in tents or caravans next to Villa Háj.

The resort offers an outside snack bar, a fireplace and sanitary facilities. Next to the villa there is a national technical sight - a hydroelectric power station - and a riding club, where you can ride a horse. Thanks to its unique architecture and countryside this area is a popular destination for cyclists, canoeists, families with children and horse lovers.



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TRAVEL TIP Mírov – Mírov hiking trail

As a point of departure you can choose the centre of Mohelnice and follow the green touristic sign through Podolí, Vyšehorky, the foothill of Vranní kopec to Mírov. At the touristic crossroad turn right and follow the blue sign through the valley of Mírovka river to Mohelnice quarry. From this place through Křemačov, following the blue sign and go back to Mohelnice town centre. Mírov village with a castle lies 7 km north-west from Mohelnice. At the beginning of Mírov, on your left hand, you will see a prison cemetery with a monument and a small chapel. From the place of the cemetery there is a nice view of the castle, transformed into a prison in 18th and 19th century.



The best cycleways of Central Moravia

Bečva Cycleway



From mountain springs into the valley you can cycle thanks to a unique project 'Bečva cycleways', which is a part of 'Highway for cyclists' C1. From the spring of Rožnov Bečva or Vsetín Bečva all the way to the place where it meets Morava river you can cycle more than 160 km on a marked cycleway along Bečva river. You will cross two regions – Zlín region and Olomouc region – small as well as bigger villages, towns, charming countryside and you can stop at many interesting places. All in all this journey will definitely be unforgettable. Some parts of this Bečva cycleway are suitable for in-line skaters, who can use a concrete path along the river and enjoy the beautiful scenery. Come and try this highway for cyclists, on a bike, scooter, in-lines or just on foot.

Hvězdná Cycleway



This cycleway from Olomouc to Šternberk is 14 km long and has the number 6104. The way is quite flat and is suitable for all age groups, for cyclists as well as inline skaters. It begins in Olomouc in Chválkovice, where you can park your car. It continues to a flyover in Černovír, from this place it leads along the railway. On the cross with a creek Trusovický potok the cycleway changes its way to Hlušovice. Near the bridge, from the left bank of Trusovický potok around Hlušovice, it links up to a cycleway to Bohuňovice. You should still follow 6104 leading along the railway to Šternberk. You can stop and have a break in Štarnov and then continue to Šternberk.

Bandit Cycleway



This cycleway of microregion Uničovsko brings you to hilly places around Oskava and to ruins of Rabštejn castle, where a group of robbers and bandits robbed rich merchants on their way to Olomouc a long time ago. The length of the trail is 40 km and it is regarded to be quite a difficult trail leading throug hilly terrain mostly on concrete cycleways and roads of third class. However, many interesting places on the way will definitely reward you. For example a neogothic Church of Maria assumption with its ostentatious interiors and modern stained glass windows in Uničov townsquare. In Dlouhá Loučka you can visit a former gothic church of St. Bartoloměj with a valuable round portal and a baroque chateau with a park full of rare woods. Šumvald is a village known since 1287, Oskava is a point of departure of many hiking and cycling trails to a proteced landscape area Jeseníky.

'Through The Kingdom of forest elves'



The cycleway around Uničov offers easy cycling through a flat region of Central Moravia suitable most of all for families with children. This area is full of cultural sights and interesting places. Your fairytale way to elves – forest guardians – starts on a comfortable cycleway from Uničov to Střelice, where all children will definitely love the paddock with horses. If you book tickets in advance, you can also visit a Village museum. From this place you continue on a non-marked concrete road directly to see the elves in their green kingdom. The forest welcomes you by the hum of trees, quiet gurgle of water and a carpet full of colorful flowers. After a while, riding over a hill Jelení kopec, you will come to a marked cycleway, where you turn left and continue to Nové Dvory. Here you pass a turn to a romantic area Nové Zámky and a village Červenka. Just after a while you can see Litovel, 'Haná Venezia'.

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


Jeseníky and its foothills are a mountain paradise with a lot of natural, historic and technical treasures. In summer you can find hundreds of well-marked hiking as well as cycling trails here. In winter it is not only about well-known winter sport resorts but also spas, various sights and many cultural events are worth visiting.

An attractive mountain terrain is ideal for keen hikers and cyclists, moreover, it is an ideal place for adrenalin sport lovers. Sheer cliffs, skydiving or sight-seeing flights from Sumperk will definitely bring you unforgettable experiences.

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Adventure in Jeseníky

Adrenalin Park Jeseníky (Česká Ves)



In a beautiful countryside of Jeseníky there are many activities prepared for you. Everybody will definitely enjoy. This rope centre offers three routes of different levels of difficulty, all of them can be combined. In total there are 47 obstacles. Adrenalin Tower is a 14 m high tower with a rope web, a ladder and a climbing wall with an overhang and minimally 6 ways of different levels of difficulty. Children 's rope centre, a route for kids, is 130 m long and is intended for children from the age of 4 and 100 cm tall. All 13 obstacles have a special self-secure system, which provides safety at all times for the children who are 1,5 - 4 metres high. A giant swing offers a huge dose of adrenalin. Next attraction is a giant ropeway - a 140 m

long descent beginning at the height of 13 metres. From here you can admire the view of all of the Adrenalin Park and its surroundings. That is not all: this park provides also horse riding, trampolines, a bungee trampoline, paintball and archery. Of course, you can rent a mountain bike or a scooter with all the necessary equipment here.

Scooter downhill Areál Kouty



Do you plan to visit the hydroelectric power station Dlouhé Stráně and don t want to come back the same way? You can rent a scooter. This will provide you an extraordinary experience during the longest scooter downhill in the Czech Republic. It is more than 17 km long and leads from the upper reservoir Dlouhé Stráně around the lower reservoir and then to the Kouty resort. Both scooters and helmets are for rent in a shop Helia Sport in Koutecké square or directly by an upper reservoir Dlouhé Stráně. You can use a chairlift to Medvědí hora (Bear mountain) - 1100 m high - with an interesting lookout. With the scooter you must then walk 4,5 km up to the upper reservoir Dlouhé Stráně. On the way you can also turn directly to the

lower reservoir and avoid the final rise. A great sports experience is waiting for you: 17 km downhill on a scooter (about 30 minutes) back to Koutecké square. On the way you can admire views of the highest peak of Jeseníky - Praděd - and the highest point of the Czech Republic (the top of Praděd transmitter).

Using a chairlift to Šerák



The chairlift leads along the northern ridge of Jeseníky and is open all year long. It consists of two parts: The lower part Ramzová – Čerňava is 1459 m long (a chairlift for four people) and the upper part Čerňava - Šerák is 1810 m long (for two people). The end of the lift is on the peak Šerák (1351 m above sea level). From here you have a wonderful view of the open valley of Jeseníky. Next you can walk on the ridges through Keprník, Vřesová studánka, Červenohorské sedlo, Švýcárna cottage, Praděd, Ovčárna, Vysoká hole, Kamzičník, Ztracené kameny and Jelení studánka to the saddle Skřítek.

A Mining open-air museum Zlatorudné mlýny



On the way from Zlaté Hory to Ondřejovice, a charming valley 'Údolí Ztracených štol' is located. A small river Olešnice has accumulated gold in its sits for millions of years. Gold has been mined both from the surface and from the depths here. Nowadays a replica of medieval mining mills with an educational path 'Údolí Ztracených štol' is built in this romantic valley. In the mills you can see how the gold ore was crushed and if you are lucky you can bring a small piece of gold home. Wooden machines, made according to original sketches, are driven by water wheels pumping energy from the former drain. The educational path leads also to a place, where 'water flows up the hill'. The optical illusion is so strong that you can hardly understand the skills of long-time gold miners.

Waterfalls Nýznerovské vodopády



Nýznerovské vodopády are located in a settlement Nýznerov by Žulová in a vallev of a creek Stříbrný potok. The waterfalls are created by a system of cascades and rapids in a romantic pass above the mouth of stream Bučínský potok. Thanks to the high waterflow Nýznerov waterfalls are very impressive. The lower part of the waterfall goes through a narrow rock pass which is difficult to access. The upper part is accessible by a staircase that leads to the bottom of a hollow. The waterfalls arose on the place, where water hit the rocks resisting corrosion. Water falls level by level into a depth of 14 m, the highest levels are up to 3 m high. Since 1968 these waterfalls have been declared a protected natural piece of work 'Vodopády Stříbrného potoka'. The best way to access this place is on a small forest road from Nýznerov, intended only for walkers.

CAMPING BOBROVNÍK ***



Camping Bobrovník is located in a valley of the Staříč river between Lipová Lázně and the town Jeseník in a recreational area Bobrovník. Peaceful surroundings of the campsite are influenced by the neighbourhood of a protected landscape area. Visitors can stay in cabins or in a motel all year long. The motel provides rooms with two or three beds, each room has its own bathroom and a toilet. Cabins have 4 beds, but you must use a common sanitary facility. Parking is possible directly next to the motel or the cabins.

For caravans there are 32 bounded pieces of land including power plugs (10A), tourists with their own tents can use a large grass area. Visitors can use washing machines and a kitchen with the possibility to keep their food in the fridge.

For romantic evenings there is a fireplace and a smokehouse. Inside the campsite you can eat in a restaurant. There you can also order half board in case you stay at least a week. In the main season basic food can be bought in a daily opened snack bar.

TRAVEL TIP Caves Na Pomezí

Caves Na Pomezí form the largest cave system in the Czech Republic created by marble dissolving, that is open to the public. The outstanding feature of these caves are narrow, sometimes very high corridors, which make so called domes on places where the corridors cross. For these caves cascades and giant jagged stalactites are typical. The underground is also a favourite place for many kinds of







Swimming is possible in a nearby natural swimming area 'Na Bobrovníku'. Inside the camp you can rent some sports equipment as well as a bike, in case of bad weather you can play snooker. A wide range of sport activities and cultural programmes are provided by the town and spa Jeseník, Lipová Lázně and its nearest surroundings.

First of all Jeseníky are suitable for all kinds of tourism – hiking, cycling, winter tourism and downhill skiing. Camping Bobrovník provides its services in winter as well, all buildings and sanitary facilities are heated.



Camping Bobrovník offers suitable accommodation for companies and other groups also off season.

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Zlatý Chlum lookout

A dominant feature of the charming town Jeseník is, besides Priessnitz spa, also a nearby peak Zlatý Chlum (875 m). You must visit a stone, 26 m high lookout. From the top of the lookout there is a breathtaking view of the lake Otmuchovské jezero in Poland and all of the Hrubý Jeseník mountain range from Praděd to Šerák. In case of nice weather you can also see Kralický Sněžník and Rychlebské hory looking north-west. To get to the top you must climb 145 stairs.



Camp Mamutov is situated in a valley of a stream Prudký potok, which makes a beautiful atmosphere here. It is very romantic to watch the sunrise and sunset from the valley. Fresh air gives you energy to go on trips around.

This campsite is suitable for all people who love camping in pure countryside in the mountains. In the camp you can find a fireplace and wooden benches under spruces for your relaxation. Although this campsite is not very large, thanks to a cottage and a guest house you will have the best service. Sanitary facilities, restaurant, a bar, touristic maps and an information centre are provided here.



Bikes can be rented as well as deposited here. Inside the resort there are some private ponds but if you like fishing, you can freely use them.

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TRAVEL TIP

A forest bar Horní Lipová



A forest bar is a self-service bar located in a village Lipová-lázně, specifically in the part Horní Lipová. You can find it on a hiking trail from Horní Lipová to Smrk after cca 2 km. Tourists can buy various beverages that are kept cool by cold spring water. They can make coffee and tea. A sign "výlov" ('fishing out') points to a wooden manger, where cans with energetic drinks, beer and beverages for kids are cooled. On an always prepared fireplace you can roast a sausage or directly take it out of a smokehouse. This forest bar is open 24 hours a day. You put money into a small money box.



Campsite Krásné is situated by a dam in a recreational area called Krásné, not far from the town Sumperk. It is surrounded by beautiful countryside and Jeseník mountains. This small resort offers a quiet family holiday. You can sleep in tents or caravans, power plugs are installed here.

Thanks to an attractive location of the campsite you can enjoy swimming, fishing, hiking, cycling, picking mushrooms or just lying by the dam on a clean beach. You can rent paddle boats. There is also a multipurpose playing field for volleyball, football, tennis and other sports. Children can play on a playground, there are also swings, slides and a paddling pool.

In summer you will definitely enjoy grills which are rentable or you can eat in a restaurant. The campsite is wheelchair accessible and there are no additional fees for pets.



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TRAVEL TIP

An exposition Witch trials

A permanent exposition in Geschaderov house in Šumperk shows the darkest period of Sumperk history, notorious witch trials from the second half of 17th century, Tragic destinies of victims of these trials are closely connected to the house where this exposition takes place. The tour in old parts of the basement takes about 40 minutes. After paying the entrance fee you will be given an audioguide. Thus the inquisitor Jindřich František Boblig himself can guide you through this place.



CAMP ČERVENKA



Camp Červenka is located in Rychlebské hory in a village Javorník and is a great choice for active relaxation. Visitors can stay in modern cabins, or their own tents or caravans. In the resort there is an outside swimming pool, a paddling pool for kids, a trampoline, a sandpit, a slide, a small football pitch and a volleyball court.

Meals can be bought in the buffet or in Javorík that is 1 km far from this campsite.

TRAVEL TIP









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Lookout on Borůvková hora

From the lookout platform, which is 24 m high, visitors can enjoy a breathtaking view of Rychlebské hory and also flatlands in Poland. The lookout was built in 2006. Hiking, cycling and cross country skiing trails lead to Borůvková hora (898 m altitude) in Rychlebské hory. This hill forms an important crossroad of hiking trails. On the peak of Borůvková hora you can find Polish guide-posts and commemorative plaques reminding meetings of Czech and Polish disidents 28 before the Velvet revolution in 1989.



CYKLOKEMP ČERNÝ POTOK



A camp for cyclists Černý Potok lies in the beautiful surroundings of Rychlebské hory, which will attract mainly pure nature lovers.

In this campsite you can stay in wooden cabins or your own tent. The resort is situated directly on many cycleways. A trail along Červený potok is popular not only with adrenalin bikers but also cyclists with families. After a hard day you can swim in nearby flooded quarries or in the swimming pool. You also have the possibility to order full board during all your stay. The beautiful surroundings are perfect for hikers, cyclists, painters, photographers, geocaching lovers or runners.



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TRAVEL TIP Caves Na Špičáku

These caves are located between villages Písečná and Supíkovice. They belong to the oldest documented caves in central Europe. They form a more than 400 m long labyrinth of corridors and rifts that used to serve as a shelter a long time ago. This is visible on the walls where you can admire paintings and inscriptions (the oldest from 1519). In winter 2007/2008 the cave was reconstructed, so visitors can walk on new paths and bridges. The corridors have a typical heart profile created by water from the glacier. The guided tour is 220 m long and is wheelchair accessible



HOLIDAY RESORT LOSINKA











Holiday resort Losinka is situated on the foothills of Hrubý Jeseník mountain range near a village Velké Losiny that belongs to the most often visited place in this region.



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TRAVEL TIP Velké Losiny chateau

A state chateau Velké Losinv lies on the south periphery of Velké Losinv village in a valley of Desná river. During a guided tour inside the chateau you will be mainly impressed by the unique knights hall decorated with leather paperwalls, a tile stove from 1589 and a cupboard for cutlery from the same year. The most valuable piece here is a tapestry carpet from 17th century showing scenes from antique mythology. In a so called baroque wing a picture gallery showing paintings from central European painters living from 17th to 19th century is installed. Beside others, a wedding 30 banquet of Přemek III. in the knights ' hall in 17th century is shown here.



CAMP RUDA NAD MORAVOU

In Ruda nad Moravou you have the possibillity to stay directly in the area of a local swimming pool in your own tents or nice furnished cabins. The large area offers enough space for relaxation as well as sport and definitely both children and adults alike will have many things to do here. There is a volleyball court, a beach volleyball court, tables for table tennis, minigolf and skittles.



You can refresh yourself at a small snack bar. The swimming pool serves also as a stop for canoeists. Also you can rent a canoe or a raft with all its necassary equipment and go canoeing down the Morava river.



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TRAVEL TIP

The museum of roads in Vikýřovice

In the permanent exposition road development from the oldest paths to modern roads is shown. You can also see many historic maps, documents and rare photographs here. There is a unique collection of badges and medals as well as a reconstructed road sledge, a buggy, wheel press or a series of pictures showing scenes from the life of a road-mender. In the outside exposition you can admire historic road machines, steel lattice bridges and parts of different kinds of other bridges: stone, wooden, iron ones and also reinforced concrete bridges.



SPORT & RELAX RESORT BOZEŇOV

Sport & Relax resort Bozeňov is situated in a peaceful area in the middle of woods. It offers accommodation, relaxation, sport and swimming.

There is an adrenalin centre where you can try archery, jumping shoes, American blowguns and a bungee trampoline. Younger children can play on a playground with a castle that they can creep through, they can use swings and ropes. There is also a multipurpose playing field with an artificial surface, a football pitch. tennis courts, beach volleyball courts, tables for table tennis and, of course, a bike rental. Nearby there is a dam Na Jahodné. Sport & Relax resort Bozeňov is crossed by a cycleway 6234 suitable for in-lines and a hiking trail perfect for nature lovers.

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TRAVEL TIP Handmade paper manufacturer and museum of paper Velké Losiny

The area of a national cultural sight in Velké Losiny offers a visit to the museum of paper, some parts of a paper manufacturer, a retail store and a trendy restaurant. The handmade paper manufacturer in Velké Losiny provides 2 guided tours. You can see traditional technologies of paper making, history of this craft and you can learn many interesting technical facts. During the main season the museum offers additional activities such as making your own paper sheet, creative workshops with our lectors, special evening tours and regular exhibitions in a museum 32 of paper gallery.





Camp and Club Bušín is situated in a submontane village Bušín. The area offers, besides 3 cabins and a place for tents, also a sheltered garden part with the possibility to barbeque and grill on your own. There is also a small children's corner, a trampoline and a playing field for ball games. You can borrow sports equipment for free here.

The camp lies by Bušínský potok creek, which meets Morava river only a short way from this place. This area is perfect for walking and cycling in magnificent scenery.








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TRAVEL TIP Háj lookout

Hái lookout near Šumperk is very beautiful and newly reconstructed. It provides an unforgettable view of Hanušovická vrchovina, Rychlebské hory, Šumperk, Hrubý Jeseník mountain range, Litovelské Pomoraví, Orlické horv mountain range and Králický Sněžník mountain. From the glassed observatory ramp, which is 24 m high, you can have a beautiful view of the ridges of Hrubý Jeseník mountain range and the town Šumperk. Looking north-east there is Praděd, north-west Králický Sněžník. In case of good visibility you can notice a basilica on Svatý Kopeček by Olomouc or Bouzov castle looking south.



GUEST HOUSE AND CAMP MLÝN



A guest house and a camp Mlýn is located in Velké Losiny. Thanks to this location visitors have plenty of possibilities where to go and what to do. You can visit a chateau, a spa park, a swimming pool with thermal healing water and many other interesting places. There are a lot of marked hiking trails and cycleways around.

Accommodation is possible in tents, in a guest house or in cabins. For guest house visitors a small kitchen with a kettle, a fridge, a microwave and basic equipment is available. All visitors can use a grill and a fireplace or borrow fishing equipment in this resort.





TRAVEL TIP

The Dlouhé Stráně Pumped-Storage **Hydro Power Station**

Dlouhé Stráně is the third largest pumped-storage hydro power station in the world. It has the largest reversing water turbine in Europe, the largest head of all power stations in the Czech Republic and the largest installed capacity in the Czech Republic. Guided tours are possible daily all year long. During the tour you will see technologies in huge underground halls, a lower reservoir and a magnificent upper reservoir with its altitude of 1350 m on







Recreational area Račí údolí is situated in Rychlebské hory, a place which is perfect for hiking and cycling. This area is extraordinary thanks to its clean air, pure nature and water, where you can meet crayfish.

The area offers an outside swimming pool, a tennis court, riding school, fishing and there are a lot of marked hiking trails and cycleways in the mountains around. Diving in a flooded quarry nearby can be an adrenalin inducing experience for you.

Cabins and an adjacent building provide all necessary sanitary facilities. You can eat breakfast, lunch and dinner directly in the kitchen of the resort.



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TRAVEL TIP Flooded quarries Na Žulovsku

Flooded guarries in the Jeseníky mountains are attractions that tourists cannot see anywhere else. They attract not only swimmers but also divers from all over the Czech Republic. For example a quarry Rampa is outstanding thanks to its high rock wall. Besides this one there are more quarries enabling swimming and relaxation not far from here - in Rokliny, in Štachlovice, in Vápenná there is a guarry Vycpálkův lom, in Skorošice you can swim in Vaňkův lom.

On the bank of Morava river, near Postřelmov, a former sand quarry is located. Today it is known as a recreational area Pískáč Postřelmov. Thanks to its position it is loved by canoeists who can refresh themselves here. In the area you can also hire sports equipment for canoeing.

During summer there are many cultural events taking place here, for more information you can find it on the website.



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TRAVEL TIP Lavender café

In May 2015 a small lavender café in the square of town Zábřeh was opened. It is a very attractive place for all lavender and coffee lovers but also for those who like wine and all people enjoying time in a cosy café scented by lavender. The café is open during a so called castle season - from April to September. You can try for example lavender cappuccino, lavender icecream, home made desserts or refreshing lavender lemonade.



A camping area FK Hanušovice is a part of an area of a local football club FK Hanušovice. It is located on Morava river 5 minutes walk from a railway station.

It is a perfect place for canoeists that want to stop and have a break on their way down the river Morava.

You can camp in tents on the grass and use a fireplace. In Hanušovice there is a pub where you can refresh yourself and enjoy Holba beer - beer from the local brewery.

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TRAVEL TIP The museum of brewing industry Holba

Visit The museum of brewery and Holba Brewery and follow the footsteps of pure beer from the mountains. You can learn about beer and its typical brewing in the past as well as nowadays. The building of the museum offers not only expositions but also a stylish brewery pub where you can, of course, taste the local Holba beer.





The best cycleways in Jeseníky

Cycleways Rychlebské stezky



Do you ride a mountain bike and enjoy narrow trails? Then Rychlebské trails are just for you – trails for mountain bikes where it is not important how far you go but where you go. Enjoy the unique scenery of Rychlebské hory and Horní Lipová surroundings. Rychlebské stezky and Lipovské stezky, which were created by reconstructions of old hunting pathways, offer the best experience to the riders. These trails do not form a line from point A to point B. However, they form connected circuits beginning and ending in Černá Voda. You can enjoy the magnificent scenery of Rychlebské hory with deep forests, giant granite stones, deserted quarries and mountain creeks. The trails lead through broken stones, through fords, on clay fields and sometimes on man-made paths made of stones. In 2017 new paths on Sokolský vrch were open to the public. New is also a Pumptrack and training trails with jumps and big stone parts for even more adrenalin.

Cycleways Lipovské stezky



Lipovské stezky are trails for mountain bikes located on a meadow above hotel Helios garden. They connect parallelly built Lipovské stezky – Toč leading through a forest terrain. Rychlebské stezky and Lipovské stezky form a web of trails intended for mountain bike downhill. Lipovské stezky consist of two types: a Helios trail on the meadow 4700 m long and Toč trail located in a forest. Its total length is 3300 m and a vertical distance 70 m. The trails connect different terrains and start and finish on one place so it is not necessary to travel from one place to another.

Witch's Cycleway ("Čarodějnická cyklotrasa")



This cycleway goes on Czech – Polish borders and connects, besides other places, Mohelnice, Šumperk, Jeseník and Polish Nysa, Otmuchow and Paczków. In Central Morava region you can stop in Mírov and Mohelnice. In Mírov there is a 12th stop with a monument in a chateau park remembering Šumperk dean Kryštof Alois Lautner´s imprisonment from 1680 to 1683.

In Mohelnice there are two commemorative plaques – on the place where the dean Kryštof Alois Lautner was burned to death in 1685 and on the wall of the so called 'witch 's house' where he was imprisoned. Alois Lauter was accused of baptisms, marriages and burying in the name of Satan.

Jescyklo



107 km of marked circuits Jescyklo go mainly through the ridge Sokolský hřbet above spa Jeseník and Česká Ves. They lead also to Zlatohorská vrchovina and under the ridges of Jeseník. Around Česká Ves, Jeseník and the spa several circuits have been created, which each average cyclist as well as skilled children should manage. They form round cycle trails guiding you through this scenery. You will stop on interesting places and at the end you come back to the start. You can take circuits "Za zatopenými lomy", "Okolo Studničního vrchu", "Tajemným hvozdem", "Za starými osadami" and "Za výhledy". The first three discover only Sokolský hřbet area, the area full of famous Rychlebské stezky trails. Better cyclists can connect directly to the trails on some places. During your way you can take a break on resting places. In Jeseník town, in Adrenalin park Jeseník and Priessnitz spa you can use the cycloboxes and store your bikes. Besides these, in Priessnitz spa, there is also a self-service available 24 hours a day. Also at the farm Orel, in Adrenalin park Jeseníky and Česká Ves you can take advantage of basic service for bikes and bike depository.
